WHAT IS MULTIPLE SCLEROSIS?

Multiple Sclerosis is

- The most common disabling neurological disease of young adults (350,000 in USA)
- A neurodegenerative autoimmune disorder of the central nervous system (CNS)
- Diagnosed in twice as many women than men.
- A disease where approximately 10,000 new cases are diagnosed (US)

Comprised of 4 subtypes:


RRMS: Relapsing Remitting

SPMS: Secondary Progressive

PPMS: Primary Progressive

PRMS: Progressive Relapsing

 A disease where periodic episodes (i.e. relapses, exacerbations,) occur with either full recovery or residual accumulating deficit




